

Master of Music in Music Education

Option B: 30 credit hours, no thesis requirement

General Requirements:

- A minimum of 30 credit hours with an overall grade point average of 3.0 or higher is required for the granting of the Master of Music, Music Education degree.
- Only three- or four-credit hour courses may satisfy education and music education electives.
- Each student in the 30-hour program must complete a Final Oral Exam.

*Each student enrolled in the 30-hour program in music education will be required to assemble a portfolio of three academic papers. This portfolio will be distributed to the three members of his/her examination committee and is due in the CRANE graduate office at least 2 weeks prior to the Final Oral Examination.

*The portfolio will consist of one paper each from MUCE 601 Philosophies and Issues and MUCE 608 Curriculum Development and a third paper of the student's choice. Papers will serve as points of discussion during the Final Oral Examination.
