

# Master of Music in Music Education

## Option A: 30 credit hours, thesis

### General Requirements

- A minimum of 30 credit hours with an overall grade point average of 3.0 or higher is required for the granting of the Master of Music, Music Education degree.
- Only three- or four-credit hour courses may satisfy education and music education electives.

### Thesis or Graduate Research Project

- A thesis or appropriate graduate project is required of all students in the M.M. Music Education, Option A: 30 credit hour degree program.
- Students must register for MUCE 699: Thesis in Music Education every semester after they begin the project until its completion.
- Students will receive "In-Progress" (IP) on their transcript each semester until the project is completed.
- A proposal must be submitted to a three-member committee by the end of the second semester or second summer of study. A student may not register for coursework beyond the second semester until the proposal has been approved.
