

# Master of Music in Performance

30 credit hours, recital

## General Requirements

- A minimum of 30 credit hours with an overall grade point average of 3.0 or higher is required for the granting of the Master of Music in Performance degree.

## Other Requirements

- Each student in the M.M. Performance program will be required to perform a graduate recital which will be evaluated by a committee of faculty members. Successful completion of the recital is a requirement of awarding of the degree.
- Prior to the recital, the student will submit the following to the committee:
  - detailed program notes of the works to be performed;
  - an analytical/historical paper focusing on the works to be performed.
- The format of the document will be at the discretion of the studio instructor.
- The document will be discussed/defended during the final oral examination.
