### Return form by June 1

SUNY Potsdam is a diverse community celebrating individual differences and intolerance of any kind is unacceptable. Participants are expected to respect the rights of others and to follow directions of staff members; therefore, I agree to:

- A. Participate to the best of my ability in all facets of the program and attend scheduled activities promptly.
- B. Respect the property and individual rights of others. The campus is not responsible for items stolen or lost. Repair or replacement of any SUNY Potsdam property damaged or destroyed will be billed to the camper(s) responsible.
- C. Abide by the program rules as follows:
  - 1. I will not leave the campus without being checked out by a parent or guardian.
  - 2. I will not possess alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, tobacco or weapons.
  - 3. I will not make inappropriate sexual remarks or advances towards any CYM camper or staff member.
  - 4. I will not use offensive language while at CYM and will treat all people and property with respect.
  - 5. I will report sickness and accidents immediately to a staff member.
  - 6. I will not have visitors except when approved by the CYM Dorm Director or Assistant Director.
  - 7. I will not bring valuable jewelry to campus.
  - 8. I will not have a pet on campus.
  - 9. I will stay in designated dormitory area (girls are not allowed in boys' area; boys are not allowed in girls' area).
  - 10. I will listen to staff and cooperate during any fire alarms and will not tamper with fire safety equipment.
  - 11. I will not play my radio or stereo too loudly.
  - 12. I will be in the dorm by 10 p.m. every night unless otherwise instructed by CYM personnel.
  - 13. I will attend all rehearsals, classes, and concerts.
  - 14. I will abide by all regulations determined by the CYM Dorm Director.
  - 15. I will not have a vehicle on campus.
  - 16. I will not bring cell phones to or chew gum in the Crane Complex, including during concerts, classes, and rehearsals.

**In the case of a major offense or repeated minor offenses, the student may be dismissed from the program. In that event, the participant's parent or guardian will be notified by phone and will be required to immediately transport the student home. No refunds will be made.**

Parental permission for field trips as part of the program is given and no further notice or consent will be necessary.
