Program participants receive a variety of academic support services and modest financial support to alleviate non-tuition costs (e.g. books, supplies etc.) Offered primarily to full-time students who are New York State residents, EOP accepts students who qualify, academically and financially, for the program.

Eligibility: To be eligible for EOP admission you must be:

- A New York State resident for 12 months prior to enrollment
- Ineligible for admission under traditional standards, but demonstrate potential for completing a college program
- Meet the income guidelines.

Please consult with your college advisor to determine if you qualify. You will be asked to complete additional application materials and financial aid forms by your college choices. Be sure to meet all deadlines.
