

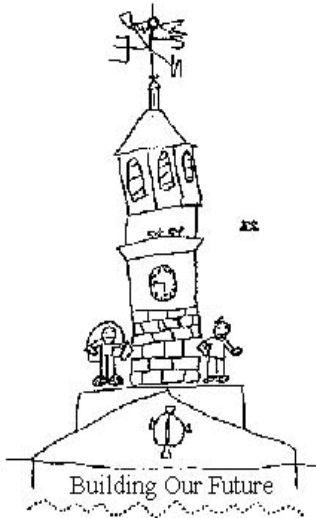

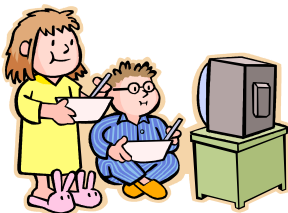
Lisa Cota plans to help us set up a worm bin (compost system). Once we learn how, the children might decide to do the same at home using a recycled milk carton.
