This Course will run during the 2007-2008 School Year and will start in the Fall of 2007. For Course Approval purposes, each of the three concert seasons represent two units of credit through SUNY Potsdam. The time commitment for each credit will exceed the traditional expectation of 15 hours per graduate credit.

**Credit:** Two, Four, or Six Graduate Credits (Cost of \$607.70 for each 2 credit course)

**Prerequisite:** There must be an available seat in the Orchestra  
By audition and/or the Conductor's invitation.

### Course Description and Evaluation Criteria:

Students will perform with the Sound Symphony to help maintain their personal performance skills. Symphonic Orchestra music of a variety of styles will be performed. Students can enroll for one, two, or three concert seasons. Each of the seasonal schedules represents two graduate credits. Students will be graded on their attendance record, a rehearsal report log, and the quality of their participation.

**Please note:** Students should understand from the beginning that the time commitment will exceed the traditional credit per time ratio. The general rule for participation is that students must attend all concerts, practice, and maintain a near perfect attendance record at rehearsals.
