SURVEY

Graduation dates: This report includes information on graduates completing degrees in August of 2006, December of 2006, and May of 2007.

Survey method and schedule. The survey was conducted four times. The first survey was handed out and collected at the College Store when students picked up their cap and gown for graduation. Graduates were surveyed by mail in November 2007, March 2008 and called in April and May 2008. All surveys were mailed first class to the latest known home address.

First Survey Results. 544 surveys were completed at the time students picked up their cap and gowns. Forty-five percent of the students who completed the survey, when they picked up their cap and gowns, were either employed, entering graduate school or not seeking employment.

Second Survey Results. This survey was mailed in mid November to 77% of the graduating class. (This number reflects those students who did not pick up their cap and gown at graduation time or who, at graduation time, were still seeking employment).

Third Survey Results. This survey was mailed early March to 72% of the graduating class. (This number reflects those students who had not replied to our second survey or who were still seeking employment at the time of the second survey).

Phone Call Results. In late April and early May, phone calls and Facebook requests were made to alumni whose placement data we were still missing. We received an 18.6% response rate from phone calls and Facebook inquires. We received a 12% response from the phone calls and a 6.6% response from Facebook inquires. This year's survey response rate was 44.7%. This is our second year of having a response rate higher than forty percent. This increase can be attributed to three factors: collecting surveys when students picked up their cap and gowns, making phone calls, and using Facebook.

REPORT RELIABILITY

The following two conditions relating to students receiving the survey affect the reliability of this, report: **(1)** *We are more likely to receive surveys from employed graduates.* We expect that students who don't have employment will not respond to the survey. To compensate for this we send information about specific employment-related services with the survey to unemployed students. **(2)** *The survey is more likely to be returned from unemployed graduates living at home.* We mail surveys to the home address on file. Employed graduates are more likely to have moved away from home and we do not have their forwarding addresses.

STATISTICAL BASE

- The "number of graduates" for each major may not include some who graduated late (incomplete grades, etc.).
- Graduates are counted in their first major only, with the exception of teachers. Also, we summarize teachers as a group.
- We realize that percentages are of no value where the respondent base is small. All returns, large or small, are included to keep the format consistent.

SUMMARY OF SERVICES FOR ACADEMIC 2006-2007 YEAR

Personnel

- Career Planning professional staff for the 2006-2007 academic year were Karen Ham, Director; Cynthia Morin, Interim-Counselor; Erin Kerwin, Counselor; Bonnie Marsh-Godreau, Secretary.
- Our student workers included: Chris Carlton, Cliff Morehouse, Katie Gadbow, Angela Silverstein, Dana Farley, Leonard Klopchin, and Esther Jerome.
- Alicia Simpson served as our Public Relations Intern for the year.

Department Presentations/Events/Appointments/Committees

- In addition to regular student services, the following presentations were completed this year: classroom - 55, on campus non-classroom -30, special career planning campus events – 5.
- We served on 11 different committees.
- We held 920 individual appointments and presented to 1,957 students in group settings, providing them with 5,059 services in 12 different categories. In addition, we served an estimated 1,000 students on a walk-in basis and answered over 3,200 phone calls.
- Of the students seen by individual appointments, 45% were seniors, 16% were juniors, 5% were sophomores, 6% were freshmen, 17% were graduate students, 10% were alumni, and 2% were community members.
- Of the students seen in workshops/presentations, 31% were seniors, 26% were juniors, 11% were sophomores, 18% were freshmen, and 15% were graduate students.

Employers

- Hundreds of companies posted jobs with our office.
- We designed an employer resume project when the free commercial resume program we were using went bankrupt. The purpose of this project is to get SUNY Potsdam students' resumes quickly in the hands of employers when the employers contact us for a list of qualified candidates. We mailed resume packets to 68 employers.

Teacher Recruitment Days

- This event was co-administered by 15 higher education institutions located in central New York.
- One hundred and twenty-nine school systems and nearly a thousand students attended this event. Eighty-eight SUNY Potsdam students registered. Sixty-four students attended

and completed nearly 336 interviews. Of the sixty-four students that attended, thirty-three were offered jobs.

Major Affair Program

- We co-administered this program with the Center for Campus Life and Alumni Offices. We directed this program towards freshmen and undeclared students.
- Every academic department was represented and 461 students attended. This was a 15% increase over last year's student attendance. It was the highest attendance record for the fifteen years that we have administered this program!
- Twenty-six percent of the students stated that they learned about majors aside from their current major, 26% of the students learned information that would help them pick a major, and 9% of the students obtained information about other majors because they were considering changing their major.

Grad Finale

- This year we co-designed and implemented a Grad Finale program with ten other campus departments and Jostens. The purpose of the program was to assist seniors and graduate students with their transition from college.
- The program was very well received by all.
- The Career Planning Office collected 349 graduate surveys at this program.

Computer Services

- FOCUS and SIGI are interactive computer career selection systems that were used by 280 students 369 times.
- Career Planning Web Page is maintained by our office and continues to be highly utilized. We spent many hours maintaining and updating our web page. We had over 16,000 hits just on our job vacancy pages.
- Student computers were used by students to produce resumes, portfolios, business cards, cover letters, job search and to access the Career Planning Web Page.

College Committees

- Karen served as Student Affairs Representative for the Faculty Senate and as a Faculty Advisor for Circle K.
- Erin and Karen served on the Teacher Recruitment Days Committee.
- Karen served as a member of Student Data Committee, Internship Committee, Grad Finale, "A Major Affair".
- Karen served on the SUNY CDO Professional Development Committee, SUNY CDO Director's Group, and the Teacher Recruitment Days Training Committee.

Community Outreach

- We held forty-seven career counseling appointments with community members.
- Karen served as the campus representative on the Associated Colleges Career Planning Committee, Board of Directors for the Potsdam Community Holiday Fund and Kiwanis.
- We presented at local area career programs and assisted with community fundraisers.

Recorded Services

These are either individual or group services given by the Director, Counselor or Public Relations Intern. In these cases, the student's name, class, major, and type of service given are recorded. More than one service may be provided during a session. We do not record walk-ins and telephone inquires. They are too numerous to track.
