## SURVEY

**Graduation dates:** This report includes information on graduates completing degrees in August of 2001, December of 2001, and May of 2002.

**Survey method and schedule.** The survey was conducted three times. The first survey was handed out and collected at graduation rehearsal. Graduates were surveyed by mail in February of 2003 and April 2003. All surveys were mailed first class to the latest known home address. No telephone follow-up is conducted because of the exorbitant cost and staff time.

*First Survey Results.* Five hundred and three surveys were completed at graduation rehearsal. It should be noted that over forty percent of the students graduating do not attend graduation rehearsal. At graduation rehearsal we collected over ninety percent of the surveys that we handed out. Fifty-one percent of the students who completed the survey were either employed, entering graduate school or not seeking employment.

*Second Survey Results.* This survey was mailed in early February to seventy-one percent of the graduating class. (This number reflects those students who had not attended graduation rehearsal or who, at graduation rehearsal time, were still seeking employment). We received a thirteen percent response from our second survey.

*Third Survey Results.* This survey was mailed mid-April to those students who did not attend graduation rehearsal, who were unemployed at graduation rehearsal and who did not reply to our second survey. We received a ten percent response from this mailing.

## REPORT RELIABILITY

Two conflicting conditions are present. **(1)** Even though we ask that surveys be forwarded, the survey is more likely to reach unemployed graduates than employed ones. Most employed people have moved from home and their addresses are less reliable. This would cause a higher return from people still seeking employment in their career field. **(2)** The survey will more likely be answered by employed graduates than by unemployed ones. We try to compensate for this by offering specific services with the survey, but we still expect a tendency to wait for good news to report. This would result in a higher return from those already employed in their field. We cannot determine the influence of these conditions on this survey. We hope that they balance out and give us an accurate picture.

## STATISTICAL BASE

The "number of graduates" for each major may not include some who graduated late (incomplete grades, etc.). Graduates are counted in their first major only, with the exception of

teachers. Although Education is a second major, we also summarize teachers as a group. We realize that percentages are of no value where the respondent base is small. We have only included small returns to keep the format consistent.

## DISTRIBUTION OF SURVEY RESPONSES

The original survey returns are sent to the Alumni Office after this report is completed for use in updating their records.

## CATEGORIES OF SERVICES

**Recorded Services.** These are given through hour appointments with the Director and Counselor or attendance at a group presentation. In these cases, the student's name, class, major, and type of service given are recorded. If an appointment covers more than one service, each topic is recorded as a service during that appointment.

**Unrecorded Services.** These are walk-ins and telephone inquiries requiring the assistance of office staff, and walk-ins picking up handouts, using our library, or using the reference file service. The Career Planning Library in our office area is used extensively, but numbers of students are not recorded. These services are too numerous and continuous to record specifically.

## SUMMARY OF SERVICE FOR 2001-2002 YEAR

### Personnel

- This year, staffing the office was a real challenge for the Career Planning Director, Karen Ham.
- The academic year began with the director being the only trained staff member.
- The office secretary, Bonnie Marsh-Godreau, was on extended medical leave from July 16, 2001- May 20, 2002.
- During the time that the secretary was on leave, the director hired and trained three temporary secretaries (Bonnie Hays, Michele Wolfe, and Tangie Moore). Bonnie Hays worked for four months. Michele worked for a month and a half. Tangie worked five months at which time Bonnie Marsh-Godreau returned from medical leave.
- The summer of 2001 involved searching for a counselor to replace Cathy Medina, who moved to Rochester, NY. Donnita Furnace, who had no experience in the career planning field, was hired. Donnita began work in September 2001.
- The director hired and trained seven student workers (Jen DeClure, Anthony LePage, John Russo, Alicia Dupray, Geoff Hobart, Maranda Murphy and Heather Robinson.)
- To complicate this situation, the Career Planning office moved into a smaller area during the summer of 2001.

### Department Presentations/Events/Meetings/Appointments

- In addition to regular student services, the following presentations were completed this year: classroom-40, on campus non-academic-14, employer meetings-14, special career planning campus events-8, and campus committee/consulting meetings-58.
- We presented 20 career planning workshops.
- We held individual or small group counseling sessions with 2,806 students providing them with 11,971 services in 11 different categories. In addition, we served an estimated 2,000 students on a walk-in basis and answered 3,888 phone calls.
- Of the students seen by individual appointments, 43% were seniors, 8% were juniors, 5% were sophomores, 1% were freshmen, 23% were graduate students, 13% were alumni, and 7% were community members. Of the students seen during group appointments, 25% were seniors, 16% were juniors, 14% were sophomores, 30% were freshmen, and 15% were graduate students. This year, the percent of services delivered to graduate students increased by 14% for individual appointments and 12% for group presentations/workshops.

## **Employers**

- Hundreds of companies posted jobs in our weekly vacancy mailing.
- We designed an employer resume project, when the free commercial resume program we were using went bankrupt. The purpose of this project is to get SUNY Potsdam students' resumes in the hands of employers the same day that the employers contact us for a list of qualified candidates. We will be implementing this program during the summer of 2002.

## **Employment Connections 2001 Job Fair**

- This was co-administered by SUNY Potsdam, Clarkson University, St. Lawrence University, and SUNY Canton Career Planning staffs. This was the third year that SUNY Potsdam has been involved in administering a local job fair.
- SUNY Potsdam Career Planning staff hosted the program.
- Fifty employers sent sixty-eight representatives to the job fair. Of the 308 students who attended the fair, 244 were SUNY Potsdam students.
- This program was extremely beneficial with expanding working relationships between SUNY Potsdam and employer.

## **SUNY CDO Real-Time Job Fair & Virtual Job Fair**

- The real-time job fair is our eleventh annual university-wide employment effort. This is our third year with a virtual job fair. Both events were coordinated by SUNY Career Development Organization with Karen Ham serving as the SUNY Potsdam Coordinator.
- Student and alumni from all SUNY schools were invited to the real-time event, which took place at the Carousel Mall in Syracuse. Fifty-five employers and over three hundred students/alumni attended. Nine Potsdam students/alumni attended this event.
- The Virtual Job Fair ran from April to May. Two Hundred and seventy SUNY Potsdam students participated in the event.
- We participated in the Virtual Teaching Recruiting Fair which was coordinated by American Association of Employment in Education. It ran from April to the end of August. The association does not keep track of candidates by college.

## **Teacher Recruitment Days**

- This event was co-administered by 15 higher education institutions located in central New York. This was the second year that SUNY Potsdam students were admitted to this event.
- Two hundred and twenty-four school systems and over a thousand students attended this event. Ninety-five SUNY Potsdam students register and received nearly 500 interviews.

## **Newsletters**

- This is the sixth year for this project. Each semester we designed and created newsletters specifically targeted to Freshman/Sophomore, and Junior/Senior audiences.
- These newsletters increased the office visibility on campus and informed the various groups about our services.
- These resulted in more students visiting the office.

## **Major Affair Program**

- We co-administered this program with Residence Life and Academic Services. We directed this program towards freshmen and undeclared students.
- Every academic department was represented and 343 students attended.
- Over one hundred students visited the Career Planning table.

## **Computer Services**

- SIGI PLUS/FOCUS - The SIGI PLUS/FOCUS interactive computer career selection systems are continually utilized by a lot of students, especially undecided students. This is the first year that we purchased the web version of the FOCUS program.
- Student Computers - These were in constant use by students to produce resumes, portfolios, business cards, cover letters, and to access the Career Planning Home Page on the Internet.

- Career Planning Home Page – Our home page, which is maintained by our office, continues to be highly utilized. We spent many hours maintaining and updating our vacancies and job search links during the year. We now provide our students/alumni with twenty-four hour access to our job listings.

### **College Committees**

- Karen served as the Enrollment and Retention Division Representative for the Faculty Assembly.
- Karen, also, served as a member of the: Transition Committee, SIFE Advisory Board, Orientation Committee, McNair Advisory Board and CIS Advisory Board.
- Donnita and Karen served on the Employment Connections 2001 Job Fair and Teacher Recruitment Day Committees.
- Karen served on the SUNY CDO Job Fair Committee.
- Karen chaired the Career Counselor Search Committee.
- Karen served as Faculty Advisory for Circle K and Disney Student Alumni groups.

### **Community Outreach**

- Karen served as the campus representative on the Board of Directors for the Potsdam Community Holiday Fund.
- Karen worked with the campus Freshmen Honor Society, Prometheus and the Potsdam Holiday Fund Board of Directors to assist local families with economic needs during the Holiday seasons. This program provided over 300 families in the six area towns with food and gifts for their children during the Christmas and Easter holidays.
- We held seventy-two appointments with community members needing career assistance.
- We presented at area high school fairs, College 101 and Gateway 2002.
- Karen is a member of Potsdam's Kiwanas. As a member of this organization Karen has volunteered many hours of service to the local community.

### **Future Direction/Challenges**

- To have all students start their career planning process during their freshman year. The challenge is convincing students, faculty and staff of the need for students to begin the career planning process during their freshman year.
- To continue to provide cutting-edge career programs/services to our students. The challenge is having the time and money to keep abreast with the constant changes in the field.
- To effectively and efficiently assist employers with finding qualified candidates. The challenge is designing and implementing a program/system with our current resources.
- Work with North Country employers. The challenge is finding the time, resources, and methods to accomplish this.
- To continue to integrate the use of technology for student and office services. The challenge is to stay abreast of technological changes in the career planning field.
- Collaborate with other Student Affairs and Academic Affairs personnel to provide integrated services that enhance student satisfaction, promote student success and increase retention of SUNY Potsdam students.

### APPOINTMENTS BY POPULATION 2001-02

This includes attendance at workshops and presentations. Appointments are one hour each and workshops/presentations are 1 to 2 hours, with attendance ranging from 4 to 60 students each. We continually encourage underclass students to use our services, as career planning takes extensive time and effort. If we can increase the number of services used at lower class levels, students will be on target in their career planning by their senior year.
