SURVEY

Graduation dates: This report includes information on graduates completing degrees in August of 2005, December of 2005, and May of 2006.

Survey method and schedule. The survey was conducted four times. The first survey was handed out and collected at the College Store when students picked up their cap and gown for graduation. Graduates were surveyed by mail in November 2005, March 2006 and called in April and May 2006. All surveys were mailed first class to the latest known home address.

First Survey Results. Five hundred and fifty-eight surveys were completed at the time students picked up their cap and gowns. Twenty-five percent of the students who completed the survey, when they picked up their cap and gowns, were either employed, entering graduate school or not seeking employment.

Second Survey Results. This survey was mailed in mid November to 75% of the graduating class. (This number reflects those students who did not pick up cap and gown at graduation time or who, at graduation time, were still seeking employment).

Third Survey Results. This survey was mailed early March to 66% of the graduating class. (This number reflects those students who had not replied to our second survey or who were still seeking employment at the time of the second survey).

Phone Call Results. In late April and early May, phone calls were made to alumni whose employment/graduate school data were missing. We added this method of collecting data in 2005 because our response rate for 2004 was at 28.3%. We received a 19% response rate from 695 phone calls. This year's survey response rate was 47.6%. This is the highest rate of return in 10 years! This increase can be attributed to 2 factors. The first factor was the change from collecting surveys at graduation rehearsal to collecting them when students picked up their cap and gowns. The second factor was making telephone calls.

REPORT RELIABILITY

Two conflicting conditions are present. **(1)** Even though we ask that surveys be forwarded, the survey is more likely to reach unemployed graduates than employed ones. Most employed graduates have moved from home and their addresses are less reliable. This would cause a higher return from graduates still seeking employment in their career field. **(2)** The survey will most likely be answered by employed graduates than by unemployed ones. We try to compensate for this by offering specific services to unemployed students with the survey, but we still expect students to not respond until they have good news to report. This would result in a higher return from those already employed in their field. We cannot determine the influence of these conditions on this survey. We hope that they balance out and give us an accurate picture.

STATISTICAL BASE

The "number of graduates" for each major may not include some who graduated late (incomplete grades, etc.). Graduates are counted in their first major only, with the exception of secondary education majors. We realize that percentages are of no value where the respondent base is small. We have only included small returns to keep the format consistent.

DISTRIBUTION OF SURVEY RESPONSES

The original survey returns are sent to the Alumni Office after this report is completed for use in updating their records.

CATEGORIES OF SERVICES

Recorded Services. These are given through hour appointments with the Director, Counselor or attendance at group presentations. In these cases, the student's name, class, major, and type of service given are recorded. If an appointment covers more than one service, each topic is recorded as a service during that appointment.

Unrecorded Services. These are walk-ins and telephone inquiries requiring the assistance of office staff, and walk-ins picking up handouts, using our library, using the reference file service or using the student computers. These services are too numerous and continuous to record specifically.

SUMMARY OF SERVICES FOR 2005-2006 YEAR

Personnel

- Career Planning professional staff for the 2005-2006 academic year were Karen Ham, Director; Donnita Firnstein, Counselor; Bonnie Marsh-Godreau, Secretary
- Our student workers included: Chris Carlton, Cliff Morehouse, Elizabeth Patnode, Ashley Cole, Angela Silverstein, and Heidi Bassett
- Mark Penell served as our Public Relations Intern for the year.
- Jennie Lee served as our Counselor Intern for the year.

Department Presentations/Events/Appointments/Committees

- In addition to regular student services, the following presentations were completed this year: classroom - 71, on campus non-academic -34, special career planning campus events – 5.
- We served on 11 different committees.
- We held 1,186 individual appointments, presented to 2,697 students in group settings providing them with 7,776 services in 12 different categories. In addition, we served an estimated 1,000 students on a walk-in basis and answered over 3,200 phone calls.
- Of the students seen by individual appointments, 40% were seniors, 11% were juniors, 5% were sophomores, 3% were freshmen, 24% were graduate students, 12% were alumni, and 5% were community members.
- Of the students seen in workshops/presentations, 29% were seniors, 21% were juniors, 19% were sophomores, 18% were freshmen, and 13% were graduate students.

Employers

- Hundreds of companies posted jobs with our office.
- We designed an employer resume project when the free commercial employer job listing program we were using went bankrupt. The purpose of this project is to get SUNY Potsdam students' resumes in the hands of employers as soon as the employers contact us for a list of qualified candidates. We mailed resume packets to 67 employers.

Teacher Recruitment Days

- This event was co-administered by 15 higher education institutions located in central New York. This was the sixth year that SUNY Potsdam students were admitted to this event.
- One hundred and eighty-nine school systems and nearly a thousand students attended this event. Ninety-nine SUNY Potsdam students registered, seventy-seven students attended and completed nearly 365 interviews.

Major Affair Program

- We co-administered this program with the Residence Life and Alumni Offices. We directed this program towards freshmen and undeclared students.
- Every academic department was represented and 400 students attended. This was a 20% increase over last year's student attendance.
- Thirty-nine percent of the students stated that they learned about majors aside from their current major, 19% of the students learned information that would help them pick a major, and 5% of the students obtained information about other majors because they were considering changing their major.

Computer Services

- FOCUS and SIGI are interactive computer career selection systems that were used by 319 students.
- Career Planning Web Page is maintained by our office and continues to be highly utilized. We spent many hours maintaining and updating our web page.
- Student computers were used by students to produce resumes, portfolios, business cards, cover letters, job search and to access the Career Planning Web Page.

Career Course

- Upon request from the Student Success Center to help with retention efforts, we taught a Career Development course.
- The goal of the course was to teach students the career planning process.
- Eighteen students registered for the course and one student dropped the course.
- Students were given a pre-assessment and post-assessment to determine their level of career planning knowledge gained from taking the course. On the average, students went from having little to no knowledge to having more than average knowledge to very knowledgeable in almost every area of the career planning process.

College Committees

- Karen served on the Faculty Senate Academic Programs and Curriculum Committee and as a Student Affairs Representative for the Faculty Senate.
- Karen served as a Faculty Advisor for Circle K.
- Donnita and Karen served on the Teacher Recruitment Day and Internship Committees.
- Karen served as a member of the CIS Advisory Board and the Student Data Committee.
- Donnita and Karen served on the SUNY CDO Professional Development Committee.
- Karen served on the SUNY CDO Director's Group, SUNY CDO Webpage Design Committee, and the Teacher Recruitment Day Alumni Committee

Community Outreach

- We held sixty-seven career counseling appointments with community members.
- Karen served as the campus representative on the Board of Directors for the Potsdam Community Holiday Fund and Kiwanis.
- We presented at local area career programs and assisted with community fundraisers.

Future Direction/Challenges

- To continue to provide the same quality and quantity of services. The challenge is having the time and resources necessary to provide the same quality and quantity of services.
- To have all students start their career planning process during their freshman year. The challenge is convincing students, faculty, staff and parents of the need for students to begin the career planning process during their freshman year and to continue the process throughout their college career.
- To continue to provide cutting-edge career programs/services to our students. The challenge is having the time and money to keep abreast with the constant changes in the field.
- To effectively and efficiently assist employers with finding qualified candidates. The challenge is designing and implementing a program/system with our current resources.
- To work with North Country employers. The challenge is finding the time and resources to accomplish this.
- To continue to integrate the use of technology for student and office services. The challenge is to stay abreast of technological changes in the career planning field and having the funds to keep resources current.
- To collaborate with other Student Affairs and Student Success Center personnel to provide integrated services that enhance student satisfaction, promote student success and increase retention of SUNY Potsdam students.
