PRELIMINARY CUBA ITINERARY

Day I: Sunday, May 20 Mid-afternoon departure from Miami to Havana

Day 2: Monday, May 21 Visit various sites around Havana. Including Plaza De San Francisco de Asis, Casa de Africa, Plaza de Armas, Plaza Vieja, Callejón de Hamel (community art project)

Day 3: Tuesday, May 22 Visit to Partagas Cigar Factory, Finea de Vigia (home of Hemingway), Depart for Cienfuegos

Day 4: Wednesday, May 23
Join SUNY Potsdam students already in Cuba! Walking tour of Punta Gorda, walking tour of Cienfuegos city center, meeting with local artists, visit to Proyecto Maraca (after school dance project)

Day 5: Thursday, May 24 Visit Universidad de Cienfuegos, Visit to the Fortress "Castillo de Jagua", Performance of Los Najanjos (exceptional Cuban band originally founded in 1926)

Day 6: Friday, May 25 Visits to Sociedad Gráfica de Cienfuegos, Provincial Museum, meeting at UNEAC and walk through the galleries

Day 7: Saturday, May 26
Depart Cienfuegos for Santa Clara, visit to Ernesto "Che"
Guevara Memorial, depart for airport, return to Miami early evening
