Enrollment Enrollment numbers for undergrads for the spring semester are concerning, but staff led the Student Success Center are making calls and connecting with student to work to resolve the number of students who have not yet registered for spring. Enrollment application numbers for grad students for spring, summer and fall are up or at par with last year.

There is increased interest in programs in Watertown and we will be looking to add programs in that market.

An Enrollment Management consultant will be on campus in March to assess our entire enrollment structure.

- <u>Bias Incidents</u> Bernadette Tiapo shared a summary of bias incident reports made to the Bias Incident Response Team during the Fall 2017 semester.
