TEACHING ASSISTANT – HIST 202

Job description:

- The TA will support the Prison Education through College Outreach by working with Dr. M. J. Heisey, who will be teaching HIST202, United States Since 1877 (AH) in fall 2018 on Fridays, 2-4:30 pm, in the St. Lawrence County Correctional Facility (SLCCF). The course will include up to 10 SUNY Potsdam students and up to 10 students from SLCCF.
- The TA will attend all class sessions and will lead one discussion section each class session.
- The TA will provide an additional 2-3 hours of support to SLCCF students, 1 office hour for SUNY Potsdam students, and 1-2 hours of grading and preparation, including weekly meetings with Heisey.
- The TA will present one lecture in the semester on a topic of his/her choice.
- Preferably, the TA will drive the van to SLCCF.

Position qualifications:

- The TA must have a BA in history.
- Preference will be given to history majors from SUNY Potsdam, who are pursuing a Master of Science in Teaching Adolescence Education in Social Studies.

Compensation will include a \$2,000 tuition remission award and a \$750 stipend for instructional costs during the fall 2018 semester.
