The BA Adolescence English Education Program follows the following gated assessment model aligned with its Learning Community structure for monitoring student progress:

Provisional Admission:

- Possess acceptable academic standing at the College of 3.0 or higher grade point average
- Read the Adolescence Education Tutorial
- Declare Adolescence English Education as a second major

Gate 1 (Upon completion of Learning Community I):

- Complete EDLS 349, SECD 210, and SECD 361, and EDLS 315 with a 2.7 or higher
- Receive a Satisfactory recommendation on Dispositions Rubrics
- Maintain an overall GPA of 2.75 or higher

Gate 2 (Upon completion of Learning Community II):

- Complete SECD 371 with a 2.7 or higher
- Receive a Satisfactory grade and recommendation for SECD 391 Practicum I
- Receive a Satisfactory recommendation on Dispositions Rubrics
- Maintain an overall GPA of 2.75 or higher

Gate 3 (Upon completion of Learning Community III)

- Complete SECD 471 and SECD 340 with a 2.7 or higher and have an overall GPA in the Education major of 3.0 or higher
- Achieve a Satisfactory grade and recommendation for SECD 491 Practicum II
- Achieve a Satisfactory recommendation on Dispositions Rubrics
- Have a 2.75 or higher GPA in English major
- Maintain an overall GPA of 2.75 or higher

Gate 4: (Graduation and recommendation for Initial Certification)

- Receive a Satisfactory grade for Student Teaching (Learning Community IV)
- Receive a Satisfactory recommendation on Dispositions Rubrics
- Achieve a grade of 2.7 or higher in all Education courses and have an overall GPA in the Education major of 3.0 or higher
- Have a 2.75 or higher GPA in English major
- Have an overall GPA of 2.75 or higher

Initial Certification

- Pass all New York State Teacher Certification Examinations (exams subject to change):
- Fingerprinting (Clearance)
- Apply to NYS for Initial Certification(s)

All required Education courses in the Adolescence English Education Program must be completed with a 2.7 or higher, and cognate courses must be completed with a minimum of 2.0 in each course.
