- Preference may be given to students based on financial need if eligibility among candidates is equal. Financial need is determined by a current Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), which must be on file in the Financial Aid Office for consideration. If the student is not eligible to file a FAFSA, alternative documentation may be considered by the Scholarship Coordinator.
