- Middle States Self Study update B. Brydges- The Middle States Commission on Higher Education is nearing the end of the data gathering process. There are only 3 standards left for the Self Study Steering Committee to review and these are scheduled to be completed this Wednesday May 25<sup>th</sup>.
- 3. Middle States Self Study Standard 14 Student Learning Assessment Draught Report Revised and disseminated to members of CAAC with input from our last meeting in December also chart of rubric: status of student learning outcomes see attached B. Brydges asked if there were any questions or thoughts. John Omohundro asked for clarification of "operationalization of college mission statement". Reply was that it is putting meaning to what is and what is not included in the statement for purposes of assessment/measurement. Phil Neisser added that this was consistent with the social sciences.
- 4. Assessment of SUNY Potsdam's Gen Ed student learning outcomes Spring 2011 for Critical Thinking Experience(FC) & Information Management (IM), First Year Speaking (FS) & Information Management (IM), Speaking Intensive (SI), Other World Civilizations (XC), and American History (AH) Brydges

  - Included:
    - Awareness of designator specific student learning outcomes
    - Sharing of best practices for assessing {assessment tools and activities}
    - Sharing and discussion of the Gen Ed data gathering instrument
    - Data collection currently underway and will be analyzed in June
    - Productive discussions from the workshops and Gen Ed, Institutional Effectiveness and LTEC will combine to conduct these again in Fall 2011 for the courses with designators to be assessed in Spring 2012 (AC, AE, FW, PI, SA, WI)S
    - sharing of best practices for capturing assessment data for each student learning outcome within the designator

- Information Literacy which is embedded in FC, and FS will be assessed for the very first time. This is a pilot 1<sup>st</sup> year – Jenica thanked Gen Ed for the help because 8 librarians cannot do it all and Middle States looks closely at this.
- The point was raised that there is need for clarification of the student learning outcomes for Information Literacy in the Faculty Handbook. This is already being addressed.
