RULES FOR CANDIDATES FOR ASSEMBLY

1. Candidates for Assembly must be full time undergraduate students at SUNY Potsdam, and be in good academic standing, i.e. must not be on academic warning or probation for the semester in which the election is held.
2. Nominating petition containing not less than 25 signatures from your district residents must be submitted to the SGA Office no later than 5 p.m. three days prior to the election.  
\*Petitions are due September 3, 2008 and the Election will be held on September 8, 2008.
3. Campaigning may be by word of mouth, printed material, or mass media. Absolutely no campaigning is allowed in the polling area. Candidates may only be in the polling places to vote and then must leave.

ANY COMPLAINTS OR CAMPAIGN VIOLATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE SGA OFFICE IN WRITING BY 5:00pm THREE CLASS DAYS FOLLOWING THE ELECTION. ALL COMPLAINTS MUST BE SUBMITTED IN WRITING.

The election is scheduled for September 8, 2008 from 10:00 am until 4:00 pm. You will be notified with the results after the voting has been tabulated. An orientation meeting for new Assembly members will take place on September 10<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m. in Room 204. The first Assembly meeting will be held at 5:00pm on September 11<sup>th</sup> in the Union Forum Room 204.
