

## ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

THE MOHAWK COUNCIL OF AKWESASNE, ST. LAWRENCE COLLEGE, & SUNY POTSDAM

The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate the transfer of Mohawk students with a General Arts and Science diploma conferred by St Lawrence College and delivered by Iohahio to the Archaeological Studies Bachelor of Arts program at SUNY Potsdam. Students transferring with the General Arts and Sciences diploma will enter Potsdam as juniors and, assuming normal academic progress, have the opportunity to complete the Bachelor of Arts degree in two additional years of full-time enrollment.

This document was developed in order to provide a seamless transfer opportunity that reduces unnecessary repetition of general education and curricular content. It complies with current SUNY Potsdam General Education requirements thereby enabling students to complete their intended program of study on time, without unnecessary cost and/or duplication of effort.

### **Admission**

- the application is available online at [www.suny.edu/applysuny](http://www.suny.edu/applysuny) ;
- an official transcript is required from every college the applicant has attended in order to be considered for admission;
- students transferring with the General Arts and Sciences diploma from Iohahio / St Lawrence College who have achieved a minimum 2.5 grade point average are guaranteed admission to SUNY Potsdam;
- transfer scholarships may be available for students with a 3.25 or higher grade point average; for more information visit [www.potsdam.edu/scholarships](http://www.potsdam.edu/scholarships) .

### **Transfer of Courses**

- all college-level courses from St Lawrence College will transfer. Visit [www.potsdam.edu/admissions/transfer](http://www.potsdam.edu/admissions/transfer) to see how courses will transfer;
- non-major courses with grades of D/1.0 will transfer; a C/2.0 or higher is required for all Archaeological Studies B.A. major requirements;
- an official evaluation of transfer credit is mailed with the admission acceptance letter.

### **SUNY General Education**

- students transferring to SUNY Potsdam with the General Arts and Science diploma must fulfill—through transfer credits or coursework at SUNY Potsdam—the General Education Foundations, Modes of Inquiry, and College Requirements in place at the time of their admission to SUNY Potsdam;
- students should complete all of their General Education Foundations and most of their Modes of Inquiry and College requirements before transferring to SUNY Potsdam;
- SUNY Potsdam staff will advise students on which requirements have been met through coursework at Iohahio.

**Transfer Services**

- students have the opportunity to attend a Transition Conference at SUNY Potsdam immediately prior to the beginning of the fall and spring semesters;
- individual advising with specially trained advisors is available for new transfer students.

This agreement commences upon the date of its signing and shall remain in effect until terminated by St. Lawrence College, the Mohawk Council of Akwesasne, or SUNY Potsdam. The Program of Study will be reviewed as curricular changes are required.
