Degree Requirements (regardless of format)

The 32 credit hours are divided as follows (All courses are 3 credits unless noted)

Required courses:

- MUCH 611 Introduction to Graduate Study
- MUCE 601 Philosophies & Issues in Music Education
- MUCE 608 Curriculum Development in the School Music Program
- MUCE 651: Contemporary Issues in Music Education
- MUCE 691: Capstone Seminar in Music Education (2 cr.)

Required areas of study:

- Music History course (MUCH 6xx)
- Music Theory course (MUCT 6xx)
- Music Performance course (MUCP 6xx)

Three 3-credit Music Education (or Education) Electives (9 credits total)

In-Person Summer Program Plan

Format:

Two five-week sessions in two consecutive summers plus two on-line courses typically taken between the two summers. [Details about the upcoming summer session are posted online](#), with details for upcoming summers being updated starting in late fall each year.

First summer:

Students take MUCH 611 Introduction to Graduate Study and three other courses, depending on if it is an even- or odd-year summer:

- Odd-year summers:
 - MUCE 601 Philosophies & Issues in Music Education
 - Music History course (MUCH 6xx)
 - Music Education Elective
- Even-year summers:
 - MUCE 608 Curriculum Development in the School Music Program
 - Music Theory course (MUCE 6xx)
 - Music Performance course (MUPE 6xx)

Fall/Spring semesters between two summers:

Students take two online courses taken between the two summers; options vary, but typically include

- GRED 516 Diversity & Advocacy in Education
- GRED 530 Classroom Management & Discipline

Second summer:
