

A minor is a grouping of courses designed to allow the student to emphasize a specific area of study. These courses may fall within the credit hour requirements of the student's degree program.

The Musical Theatre minor can be elected by students in any major who are accepted into the minor through an audition and interview process. The audition/interview will include a short monologue, a song, an example of movement, and a conversation with faculty. Auditions/interviews will be scheduled in February each year, with criteria for acceptance clearly defined.
