

Questions for Readmitted Students

? I am back in college. How do I stop making payments on my student loans?

Enrollment in college for six (6) or more credit hours will qualify you for an in-school deferment. The Registrar's Office automatically reports electronically regarding your enrollment status. If you are registered for six (6) or more hours, you will not have to repay on your student loans and they should be automatically reverted to a deferment status.

? I am readmitted to the college after a period of absence. Am I eligible for financial aid?

You are not automatically eligible for federal and state aid upon readmission to the college.

If you are readmitted or have been granted academic forgiveness for previous coursework, you are subject to the standards defined in the institution's policy for federal aid eligibility. Academic progress will be reviewed upon readmission and receipt of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). All previous coursework at SUNY Potsdam must be included in each review of academic progress for federal aid; therefore, even coursework you had "forgiven" academically must be considered in the review.
