Admissions

- Students entering SUNY Potsdam having earned an Associate's degree from a regionally accredited two-year college will be admitted with full junior standing.
- Students who have completed at least seven, but fewer than ten, of the General Education Learning Outcomes (as defined by SUNY) will have fulfilled Potsdam's Freshman Experience requirements.
- An overall GPA of 2.5

About the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration

A background in business administration provides students an understanding of how for-profit and non-profit organizations function effectively and efficiently. Students gain a comprehensive understanding of the entire organization and a clear picture of how the following functional business areas work together to make a successful organization: accounting, finance, human resources, law, management, sales and marketing, information technology, product development and operations.

Associate in Science Degree from Bronx Community College.

Bronx Community College graduates with the Associate Degree in Business Administration, Management Option will receive 60 credits toward the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration at SUNY Potsdam. In addition, they will be deemed to have met all general education requirements at Bronx Community College.

F. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

BCC Students may be eligible for the following scholarships:

- **SUNY Potsdam Transfer Scholars Program**
