The Courage to Teach: The Work of Parker Palmer

Abstract. This presentation will consider the intellectual work of Parker Palmer that led to the development of the Courage to Teach movement and then Circles of Trust for other professions. The fundamental tenants of the Courage to Teach work will be explored as well as the principles and practices upon which this work is based. Research related to the impact of this approach for professional satisfaction as well as for improving relational trust in organizations will be examined.
