**OBJECTIVE A:** CSTEP will provide the supports for students to participate in faculty-guided academic year research/internships and summer research/internships to include stipends, housing, travel funds, etc.

TARGET: provide 15 student research/internship stipends annually

**RESULT:** Provided research/internship stipends to 26 students during the 21-22 academic year – **SURPASSED OUR TARGET** 

**OBJECTIVE B:** CSTEP will recruit/assist students to apply for Kilmer funds and the Presidential Scholars Program for independent student/faculty collaborative research.

**TARGET:** 3 students annually to successfully apply for Kilmer funds and/or participate in the Presidential Scholars Program.

**RESULT:** 3 students successfully applied (1 Presidential Scholar, 2 Kilmer) – **MET OUR TARGET for successful applicants.** NOTE: 1 student unable to complete the requirements due to financial aid concerns.

**OBJECTIVE 3:** CSTEP will recruit students for UAlbany Summer Research Program (UASRP), Brookhaven-CSTEP Research Program, SUNY Optometry CSTEP Internship, NERA-Medprep, Summer Health Professions Education Program (SHPEP), Clarkson McNair Program, and other externally funded opportunities, such as NSF-REUs.

TARGET: 4 successful applicants annually

**RESULT:** 4 students successfully applied and participated in externally funded research/internship opportunities (1 - National Security Agency (NSA) funded MATH (REU); 2 – Global Virtual Internship Program; 1 - Huari-Ancash Bio-Archaeological Research Project Field School in Peru (through Tulane University) – **MET OUR TARGET**
