Adding Extended Time for a Quiz

You may find you need to accommodate students who require longer times on tests. Here is how it is done in Moodle's Quiz Activity.

Step 1

On your course landing site, choose the gear symbol in the top right and choose "Turn Editing On"

Step 2

Click on your Quiz Activity to enter it. If you have not setup the Quiz yet, do that first - Save it, *then* proceed with the following steps.

Step 3

Once the Quiz Activity is open, choose "User overrides" from the gear symbol on the right.

Step 4

Choose the green "Add user override" button.

Step 5

In the "Override user" section, click the black down-ward pointing arrow. You will see a list of your students.

Step 6

Click on a student to select them, you can tell when they have been selected when you see the name in grey text. It will look something like this:

Scroll down a little, you will see a section called "Time Limit". Check the check box, and enter the desired time limit. This will override the time limit set for the quiz for the selected student(s).
