

Consistent with New York State Education Law 129-B and policies of The State University of New York, SUNY Potsdam participated in the 2025 University-wide Biennial SUNY Uniform Campus Climate Survey. The Survey gathered information about student and employee experience with sexual and interpersonal violence and knowledge of policies and resources.

Of the 2,344 students who were invited to participate, 269 responded, a response rate of 11.5%. The overall response rate for SUNY 4-year campuses as a whole was 4.9%.

In response to the survey 39.6% of students said they had experienced sexual harassment and 17.8% of students indicated they experienced sexual assault. 12.8% reported experiencing stalking. 21.2% of respondents indicated they reported their experiences via a formal process.

According to the survey, 82.5% of students are aware that the campus has policies and procedures addressing sexual assault and 60.4% indicate that they know how to contact the Title IX Coordinator. 74.6% indicated they know how to report a sexual assault.

SUNY Potsdam, working with SUNY and community colleagues (including students, faculty, and staff), will use these data to improve response to violence, develop prevention programs, and will continue to study the issue.
